

RE: CESASC Calls Your Support to China Earthquake Relief

Dear CESASC members,

Since the devastating 8.0-magnitude earthquake struck on May 12, millions of residential houses and commercial buildings have been destroyed and tens of thousands have lost their lives across Sichuan province in southwestern China. Up to May 20, 16:00pm (Beijing Time), 6526 aftershocks have struck in Sichuan province and still more are anticipated.

According to the latest reports by May 20, 2008 (Beijing time), here are some tragic numbers, which are still expected to rise dramatically:

40,075 died.

247,645 injured.

32,361 people are still missing.

5,000,000+ homes destroyed,

7000 schools destroyed, many kids were buried in the debris

Among those who died, many are school children, and some are the only child of their parents due to the one-child policy. Also, thousands of young children lost their parents and became orphans.
